The study, *Inappropriate Drug Use in the Chronic Pain Population*, tracked over 900,000 urine toxicology tests performed on more than 500,000 patients who were prescribed chronic opioid therapy. The findings showed that nearly 75% of patients may not be taking their medications as prescribed.

"We believe that the combined program with CMT will bring additional value and a return on investment to the insurance and employer market while helping to reduce the adverse effects caused by opioid overuse," explained Ameritox's Chief Medical Officer, Harry L. Leider, M.D. Dr. Leider has
